Treat all conductors as if they are hot, even if they are on the ground. Always use your rubber gloves when handling conductors. Your rubber gloves are your first line of personal protection and defense from voltage induction and other stray voltages that will find their way to conductors. Isolate, and insulate. Keep yourself from becoming a path to ground or a parallel path for electricity to be conducted through. Ask yourself, what if this conductor I'm about to grab has somehow become energized? Would you touch it with your bare hands? Better safe than sorry, always error on the side of safety.
